**Directions to the Old Mill Marina and the Eagle Lake Sporting Camps:**

The Old Mill Marina is the meeting place for guests travelling to the camps by boat. The scenic seven mile pontoon boat ride takes you along the unspoiled shores of the 23,000 acre Eagle Lake reserve. The trip takes about 20 minutes.

Parking, bathrooms, ice, fuel, and boat rentals are available at the Marina. Full hook-up RV and tent sites are available along with showers, a bunk house, and cabin rentals.

From the South:

1. Take I-95 North to exit 286 "Oakfield"
2. Turn Left onto State Rt. 212 (West) - follow to the end (10 miles)
3. Turn Right onto State Rt. 11 (North) – (Caution moose) - travel through the towns of Ashland and Portage to the Town of Eagle Lake – about 70 miles from I-95
4. Turn Right onto "Old Main Street" (directly before Eagle Lake Grocery) go ½ mile
5. Cross a railroad track – the Old Mill Marina is ahead on the left. The Marina phone number is 207-444-7529.

From Presque Isle Airport (58 Miles) to Old Mill Marina

1. Leave Airport parking by going Left on Airport Drive - go .05 miles
2. Turn Right on Skyway Street - Go 1.1 miles
3. Turn Left on State Rd, ME-227 go 22.9 miles to Ashland (Caution hills and curves)
4. Continue on ME-11 to Portage – then 24 miles to the Town of Eagle Lake (Caution moose)
5. Turn Right onto "Old Main Street" (directly before Eagle Lake Grocery)
6. Cross a railroad track – the Old Mill Marina is ahead on the left. The Marina phone number is 207-444-7529.

### **Gravel Road to the Camps (20 miles from State Route 11)**

The camps have seasonal access via 20 miles of privately maintained gravel roads. Please confirm the road is passable before attempting to drive to the camps. Call us from Ashland at 207-444-5108 x 3 and give us a progress report. Leave a message with the time if our voice mail system answers. Cell phone service is spotty. A 4WD vehicle is highly recommended and a must during the wet conditions of spring and fall. Road repairs can force the road to be closed for weeks.

The following are directions from the south on Route 11. The timber companies maintain mile markers to help navigate; however, certain markers may be missing or damaged:

1. After passing through the Town of Portage travel North on State Rt. 11 for about 14 miles.
2. Turn right (immediately North (and across Rt. 11) from Hedgehog Mountain State maintained Rest Area) onto Pennington Road (gravel) - follow to the end (should be multiple mile markers) – about 11 miles
3. Turn Left onto Square Lake Road and join mile 7.5. Follow Square Lake Road to mile 12.5
4. Turn Left onto Eagle Lake Sporting Camps Road - 4 miles to the end; please open and close gate as instructed

### **Gravel Road to the Camps from Caribou (32 miles)**

The camps have seasonal access via 20 miles of privately maintained gravel roads. Please confirm the road is passable before attempting to drive to the camps. Call us at 207-444-5108 x 3 and give us a progress report. Leave a message with the time if our voice mail system answers. Cell phone service is spotty. A 4WD vehicle is recommended and a must during the wet conditions of spring and fall. Road repairs can force the road to be closed for weeks.

The following are directions from Caribou. The timber companies maintain mile markers to help navigate; however, certain markers may be missing or damaged:

1. Travel 8 miles on State Route 161 toward New Sweden.
2. Turn left at NorthStar Variety onto Westmanland Road.
3. Travel 2.8 miles (Westmanland Road makes a 90 degree turn to the right) go straight onto Blackstone “Siding” Road (gravel).
4. Stay on Blackstone “Siding” Road until you get to a stop sign. (about 7 miles)
5. Turn right at stop sign onto Blackstone Road – around mile 23.
6. Travel on Blackstone Road until mile marker 26. Turn left onto the Square Lake Road.
7. Travel on Square Lake Road to Mile 12.5.
8. Turn Left onto Eagle Lake Sporting Camps Road - 4 miles to the end; please open and close gate as instructed.
